## Vietnam vet to share his story, photos

Forty years after he served in Vietnam, Erie native and noted nature photographer Michael Moryc returned.

He called the experience "a journey taken to confront those dragons from my youth. While part of the Vietnam experience has now been reframed for me, there will not be a day that my life is not in some way touched by having been there the first time."

Moryc has mounted an exhibit of his works from that visit. "Return to the Land of Dragons" will be on display in the Mercy Heritage Room of Mercyhurst University's Sullivan Hall starting Monday from 6 to 10 p.m.

Moryc will also talk about his Vietnam experience — including his struggles with post-traumatic stress syndrome — on Monday at 7:30 p.m. at Mercyhurst's Taylor Little Theatre.
